COVID-19 UPDATE – 9TH JULY 2021

GREATER SYDNEY LOCKDOWN EXTENSION

On Thursday 8th July the Premier of NSW, Gladys Berejiklian, announced an extension of the existing stay at home directive for the Greater Sydney Area including the Blue Mountains, Central Coast, Wollongong and Shellharbour local government areas. Due originally to expire on Friday 9th July, the new end date is now 11:59pm on Friday 16 July 2021. However since that time, the Premier has given clear indication that given the ongoing increase in Covid-19 infections, further extensions are likely.

Additional restrictions have also been introduced wrt:

- Reasonable excuse to leave home
- Shopping
- Exercise
- Visitors (Compassionate)
- Face Masks

No community sport (whether training or a match) can be conducted in the Greater Sydney Area including the Blue Mountains, Central Coast, Wollongong and Shellharbour during this time.

It is anticipated that these new restrictions will now stay in place indefinitely, subject to amendment as the situation wrt Covid-19 infections dictates.

As a consequence, all current Lunchtime Legends competitions will remain on hold until such time as restrictions are eased that allow the recommencement of play.

We remind everyone that we all hold personal responsibility to do our part in containing the virus. The NSW Government has issued a number of additional directives, we ask that everyone familiarise themselves with these and follow these as they apply to themselves.
